Subject: Instructional Program, College Courses for Central Catholic Students





Policy Content:

Central Catholic High School students may, upon the approval of the Administration, take post-secondary/dual-credit courses for high school credit.

Criteria for approving such a course would include:

- The student is scheduled to meet all the course requirements for the State of Indiana and Central Catholic.
- The student has demonstrated aptitude for advanced course work.
- The course meets the standards of approval by the State Department of Education.
- Grades in these courses become a part of the student's GPA and are recorded on the student's transcripts.
