



The National Weather Service is predicting dangerously cold temperatures beginning Tuesday night lasting through Thursday morning. Our first priority is always the safety of our students and staff. The frigid temperatures **may** cause LCSS schools to close on Wednesday and Thursday. **This document is designed to help parents understand how LCSS schools will proceed with virtual learning on days when onsite attendance is not possible.** LCSS will refer to virtual learning days as eLearning. Use of eLearning days will be limited.

LCSS eLearning

Teachers in all grade levels have instructed students on how to complete lessons and assignments on an eLearning day. Students enrolled in grades K-6 practiced these instructions and participated in a mock lesson during school on Monday, January 21st, 2019. Principals, teachers, and students in all grade levels have expressed confidence and excitement about moving forward with eLearning days when weather prevents onsite attendance.

eLearning FAQ

Q: What device will my student use to complete eLearning?

A: Central Catholic Jr. - Sr. High School students will complete assignments using their school issued MacBook Air. Elementary students will use their school issued iPad. **iPads will be sent home with students the night prior to an anticipated eLearning day.**

Q: How will the school take attendance on an eLearning day?

A: All students will complete an online form located on each school's website. The form requires students to be signed into their LCSS Google account.

Q: Where will my child find his/her lessons for the day?

A: Central Catholic Jr. - Sr. High School students will login to Schoology to access their lessons. Lessons will be posted by 9:00 am. Elementary students will find lessons posted on their respective school's eLearning website by 9:30 am.

Q: When will eLearning assignments be due?

A: All eLearning assignments are due the next day when class starts. Of course we understand various issues may prevent a student from completing the assignment. Students or parents should contact the teacher if there are questions about an assignment. All technical problems and questions should be directed to helpdesk@lcss.org.

Q: What do I do if I do not have Internet or the Internet is temporarily unavailable?

A: If you do not have Internet, please contact helpdesk@lcss.org or call (765) 607-4908. If your Internet goes out during the eLearning day, please email your teacher or send a handwritten note to school explaining the situation.

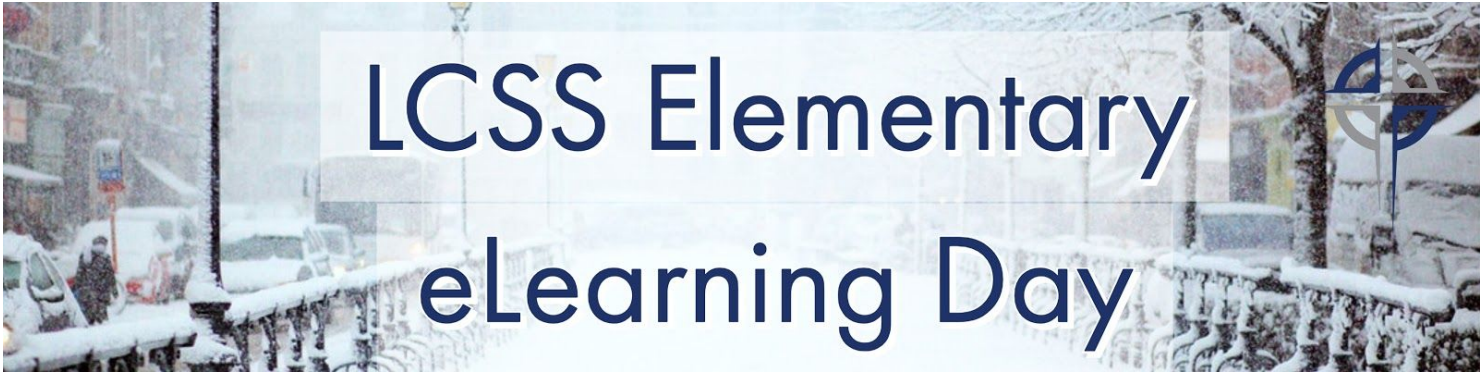
Q: Will my student be on the computer all day?

A: The screen time on an eLearning day will vary by age level. Total screen time will fall below the total screen time limit established by the American Academy of Pediatrics.

Q: Will students have two consecutive eLearning days if school is cancelled on both Wednesday, January 30th and Thursday, January 31st?

A: If school is cancelled elementary students will **ONLY** participate in eLearning on the first day (Wednesday, January 30th) due to concerns with iPad battery life. CC students will participate in eLearning both days.

ELEMENTARY eLearning Guidelines

- If the weather appears likely to cause a school cancellation **iPads will be sent home with students the day prior to a possible cancellation.**
- Teachers will post lessons on the school’s eLearning page. See eLearning website links below.
- Lessons will be posted by 9:30 am the morning of the eLearning day.
- Homeroom teachers are available by email from 9:30 am - 2:30 pm on eLearning days.
- Assignments will be due the day students return to school.
- Accessing and completing the assignments will require Internet access. If you do not have home Internet access please contact the LCSS Help Desk to discuss possible alternatives.

- All iPads should be sent back to school with the student on the next school day. Parents do not need to charge the iPads before sending them back to school.

Elementary eLearning Attendance

On eLearning days attendance will be taken using [THIS ATTENDANCE FORM](#). Students will be able to access the form using their school issued iPad and LCSS Google Account. We encourage parents with students in grades K-2 to help their child complete this form. Students’ Google account usernames and passwords are located on the back of their iPad. **This form must be completed by the end of each eLearning day.**

CENTRAL CATHOLIC JR - SR - HIGH SCHOOL eLearning Guidelines

- If the weather appears likely to cause a school cancellation an eLearning day may be used.
- Teachers will upload their lessons to Schoology.
- Lessons will be posted by 9:00 am the morning of the eLearning day.
- A full lesson should take students 20-40 minutes to complete. Students will have one lesson per class.
- The lesson will contain new or review material. Students will be afforded the opportunity to complete the assignment and submit the assignment with the guidelines established by individual teachers.
- Teachers will be available via Schoology messages between 9:00 am and 3:00 pm to answer any questions posted by students.
- All eLearning assignments are due the next day when class starts.
- Accessing and completing the assignments will require Internet access. If you do not have home Internet access please contact the LCSS Help Desk to discuss possible alternatives.
